

# Lent

As I write this article on the second Sunday of Lent, we have not long ago commemorated Ash Wednesday with an 'Ashing' service, as we moved into the season of Lent.

The word "Lent" is thought to have originated from the Old English word for Spring, *lengten*. But before that it was known by its Latin name of *Quadragesima* which means 40 days; a significant number in the Bible as it links back to the 40 days that Moses fasted on Mount Sinai before receiving the 10 Commandments (Exodus 24:18), the period that Elijah walked in the desert to meet God on Mount Horeb (1 Kings 19:8) and, most significantly of all, the period of time Jesus spent in the wilderness before beginning his ministry (Luke 4: 1-15).

Lent, therefore, has very strong links with this Biblical time of preparation - at the end of which comes new revelation.

In some ways today, we have lost a bit of this in that, if Lent is kept at all, it is often simply seen as an opportunity for giving something up. There is, of course, a spiritual dimension, because in giving something up we are breaking any hold that something may have over us; and through it we reassess who or what really rules in our lives.

And of course, as we are Christians, then it should be Jesus who is our Lord.

The danger in keeping Lent only in terms of giving something up is that the focus of our attention is upon ourselves rather than upon God. Instead, Lent should be an opportunity for us to re-evaluate the things that are important in our lives and to refocus upon Jesus. To do this many people join Lent Courses or set aside more time to read and explore their Bibles.



During Holy Week there will be more opportunities for us to refocus on Jesus and the journey to Easter morning. On Maundy Thursday (28<sup>th</sup> March) I will be holding a Tenebrae Service at Boston Spa Methodist Church, starting at 7pm. The service of Tenebrae, meaning "darkness" or "shadows," has been practiced by the church since medieval times. Once a service for the monastic community, Tenebrae has become an important part of the worship during Holy Week. It provides an opportunity to think about Christ's suffering; in the service, readings trace the story of Christ's passion, music portrays his pathos, and the power of silence and darkness suggests the drama of that momentous day.

There are various opportunities to worship or witness, around the Circuit, throughout Holy Week. Have a look at the feature, later in this newsletter, to see what is happening near you.

Please do use these opportunities to refocus on Jesus this Eastertide, and journey with him through the week that commences with Palm Sunday and concludes with Easter Day - taking us on a spiritual journey that takes us into a new revelation.
