As you may know, Boston Spa and Clifford Chapels are offering an Alpha Course, starting 8th January. Some of you will be familiar with these, having already attended or even helped to run a course but I thought it might be helpful just to give a brief outline and to ask whether there are any lessons for our Circuit?

It's a very simple idea. Over 11 weeks folk get together for a couple of hours each week to:

- Share a meal (a chance to get to know each other),
- Watch a video (which raises issues like 'Who was Jesus and why did he have to die?' and 'Why and how do I pray?')
- Discuss the issues, in an open, friendly way no pressure, just a chance to share thoughts

And that's it. Last year globally, over 2 million people joined a course, over 300,000 in the UK alone – so they must be doing something right! Here are a few lessons for our Circuit:

- 1. There's a huge hunger 'out there' people want to know 'is there more to life than this?'
- 2. Church is not the answer (at first). At the recent hugely successful Boston Spa Christmas Tree Festival, we had hundreds of young parents coming through the door how many would come back on a Sunday? I suspect hardly any would take that as their first step to finding answers but may choose to become involved further down the road.

- 3. Sharing a meal and open discussion remind you of anyone you know who did that 2,000 years ago?
- 4. Sharing faith, not through theology but through real life stories, not just the certainties but also the doubts, leaving you space to think for yourselves remind you of anyone?
- 5. There's no need to 'reinvent the wheel', the resources are there waiting to be used.
- 6. People need to be invited, people we all know.

Throughout January, all of the Churches in our Circuit are sharing the 'Covenant Service', where we hear the words 'Christ has many services to be done, some are easy, others are difficult, some are suitable to our natural inclinations, others are not yet the power to do all these things is given to us in Christ, who strengthens us'

And we respond 'I am no longer my own but yours. Your will not mine be done in all things'. Looking into the New Year and specifically this Covenant season, this is maybe a good time to reflect on what our Churches can be doing for those 'out there' looking for answers. Maybe even more, to reflect on what YOU can do.

What I have discovered over the years is that if we do something and it is the right thing, at the right time, God will help us in ways we hadn't imagined. Alpha might not be right for your Church, or not right, right now – but the lessons set out above still apply. Picking up on Paul's message, are we willing to share not only the Good News but our lives as well?




